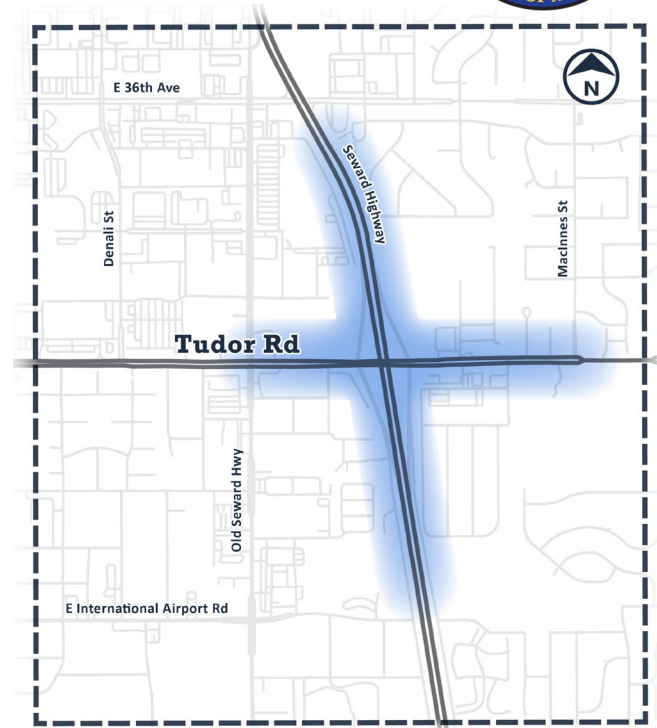

Project Description

The State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is planning to improve the Seward Highway and Tudor Road interchange in midtown Anchorage. This interchange is the interface between Anchorage's busiest north/south arterial and the busiest east/west arterial, providing essential access and mobility for the entire Anchorage Bowl. Planned improvements include:

- Replacing the Tudor Road bridge over the Seward Highway to meet current design standards
- Rehabilitating and possibly realigning the interchange ramps and intersections to improve safety and mobility
- Building a wider Tudor Road bridge to create more space for non-motorized traffic and additional turning lanes.
